

Web site Privacy Statement

This statement has been written to let users of the College of Law web site know what information is collected about them, how the College uses it and whether it is disclosed to others.

The information we collect on your visit

When you look at this site, our computers automatically record information that identifies, for each page visited:

- The IP address of the machine that has accessed the site;
- Your top-level domain name (eg .com, .edu, .gov, .au, .ae etc)
- Your server address and logon name;
- The date and the time you accessed the site;
- The pages you visited and the documents you downloaded;
- The previous site you visited; and
- The type of browser you used.

Exceptions to the rule of anonymity

The College of Law will make no attempt to identify individual users or their browsing record except in the following circumstances:

- Unauthorised attempts to access files not published on the site;
- Unauthorised tampering or interference with files published on the site;
- Unauthorised attempts to index the contents of the site;
- Communications which are defamatory, abusive, vilify individuals or groups or which give rise to suspicion that an offence is being committed; and
- Attempts to otherwise compromise the security of the web site.

In the event of an investigation for suspected offences, the College of Law will give relevant law enforcement agencies access to College of Law logs.

Email addresses

Email addresses are only recorded if you send us email messages. Such addresses will be used by the College of Law for the purposes for which you have supplied them, and for the College to provide you with future information. They may also be used in conduct research into your training needs. No information will be sold to third parties.

Collection of personal information

The College of Law site may, from time to time, contain electronic forms for users to request further information. If any personal information is recorded when you make requests, that information will be used only to allow us to respond to your requests and provide future information and conduct research in order to identify your training needs. No information will be sold to third parties.

Certain areas of the College of Law site are accessible only by registered users whose status will be verified before access is granted.

Storage and disposal

If personal information is collected via a website this will be done by sufficiently secure means.

All information is stored in a secure format and held for statistical and archival purposes. When no longer required, information is deleted.
