CRITERIA FOR BURSARY

The main criterion is financial hardship. The aim of the bursary scheme is to provide financial assistance to students who would otherwise be constrained from commencing the Professional Program by inadequate resources. Details of bank accounts, salaries, other income, dependants, mortgage payments and expenses are all relevant and should be included in your Statutory Declaration.

Applicants for bursaries must be Australian citizens or full permanent residents (with no further waiting period).

Onus

The onus is on the applicant to establish financial hardship.

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Applicants

You will need to provide evidence of Aboriginality or Torres Strait Islander background, such as a letter from:

- A university or other tertiary institution confirming prior evidence to it of your background
- a government department or agency (e.g. ATSIC, DEEWR),
- A Community organisation or
- Of a similar nature from a reliable source

Decision Final

The decision of Bursary Committee is final and there is no appeal process.
